## Show Information

It's good to be back! We hope you all enjoy your time at the show(s) and would request that you take the time to read through the following information as this will help to ensure that the shows run smoothly. Due to current government restrictions there are some important differences from previous shows.

### COVID-19

Agility Nuts will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. We reserve the right to cancel should guidelines so dictate, in which case refunds will be offered.

It is your responsibility to ensure you comply with national and local restrictions including advice given about non-essential travel in and out of locally affected regions (which must not be ignored) – in the interests of the safety of all participants this may give rise to a short notice refusal of entry at the our discretion.

**If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must isolate in line with Government advice -**

### **The competitor must not attend the event**

Please note that if local restrictions or self-isolation prevent you from attending refunds cannot be offered after the closing date if the show is able to go ahead.

### Test and Trace

In line with current government guidelines, we are required to have a complete list of people attending the show, including all accompanying non-competing individuals. Please complete the form at <https://form.jotform.com/211731330781347> prior to the show, submitting one form per person. If you are competing we already have your details so there is no need to complete the form. If any submitted information changes please either email us ahead of the show ([paul@agilitynuts.co.uk](mailto:paul@agilitynuts.co.uk)) or let us know in the Show Office on arrival.

### Walking the courses

- Facemasks must be worn when walking courses
- No more than 30 people can walk the course at once
- To help with this, courses may be walked as follows
  - Veteran/Nursery/Anysize – please walk the course when it is set for your class
  - Large/Intermediate Elementary – please walk the course when it is set for your class and height
  - ABL Elementary – please walk the course when it is set for your class and height
  - Starters – please walk the course when it is set for your class, i.e. all heights can walk at the same time
  - Novice Plus – please walk the course when it is set for your class, i.e. all heights can walk at the same time
- The main difference is that **Large/Intermediate and ABL Elementary handlers should NOT walk the course together. Please do not break this rule** – it is a COVID enforced restriction and the show could be closed down if council inspection deems this to have been broken

**Getting to the line and queuing:** Please be aware of when you need to run your dogs! If you have multiple dogs to run please stagger your runs to make sure that the end of the class is not delayed whilst the Judge waits for you to go and get your next dog. Please maintain 2m social distancing gaps between each other when queuing. Lines will be sprayed on the ground at 2m intervals to help with this.

**Leads and toys:** For these shows, handlers may “wear” their leads or put them in a pocket as there will be no handling of leads by the ring party. Non-squeaky toys may be carried in the hand in Elementary and Veteran/Nursery/Anysize classes and may be used to reward the dog at the end of your run (note that throwing a toy over the last jump before the dog has taken it will result in an elimination), unless you are doing a training round, in which case you can reward as you wish.

**Food in the rings:** NO food in the rings please.

**Training rounds:** We do permit training rounds at all levels. You MUST declare that you are training when entering the ring (your score will be marked as an E) and you will be given 50 seconds of training time (note that this may be reduced at the discretion of the show management).

**Helpers:** We would appreciate any help that you can offer during the course of the day. Please ask ringside or in the office if you are available to help and listen out for calls to cover rings whilst ring party member attend and run their own dogs.

**Day parking:** All competitors should enter through the main entrance on Eakring Road and follow the track around the back of the Bowling Greens to the day parking area. **Please allow 2m between all vehicles. Please park as directed if a steward is on duty.**

**Dogs in cars:** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle at high temperatures, even on days that you may only consider to be slightly warm. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for the damage caused.

**Camping:** Camping is available **from 2 pm on the Friday** before the show starts. All campers must vacate the venue by 11 am on Monday morning. Pitches will not be marked, so please choose pitches sensibly with no back to back garden arrangements. All camping units must have a fire extinguisher and/or bucket of water available. Toilet facilities and water taps are available at the venue.

**Toilets:** The toilets are located in the clubhouse. **Please maintain 2m social distancing whilst queuing.**

**Hygiene:** Sanitisation stations will be located at various points on the venue, but you are strongly advised to bring your own sanitiser with you and use it appropriately.

**Exercise area:** You may use any area that is not out of bounds (essentially anywhere except the bowling greens!) to exercise your dogs. Please **do not** throw balls for your dogs anywhere near the rings. that are out of bounds will be clearly marked and must be respected. All owners must pick up after their dogs – no exceptions! Bins for dog waste will be provided. Owners knowingly not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue and may be excluded from future shows.

**Catering:** Catering will be provided onsite by The Gastropod (July 10-11) and The Curry Box (July 17-18).

**Photographer:** Paul Fiddian Pet Photography (<https://www.facebook.com/PaulFiddianPetPhotography>) will be covering the July 10-11 show.

**Results:** Agility Nuts will be using ringside entry of results with real-time updates of the current standings as each class runs available on your mobile devices at <http://mobile.firstplaceprocessing.com>. Note that we will not be using our results display this summer and there will be no access to show supplied devices for competitors to check results. Results will be announced asap after each class finishes and medals/rosettes can be collected as soon as the announcements have been made.

- Agility for Competition

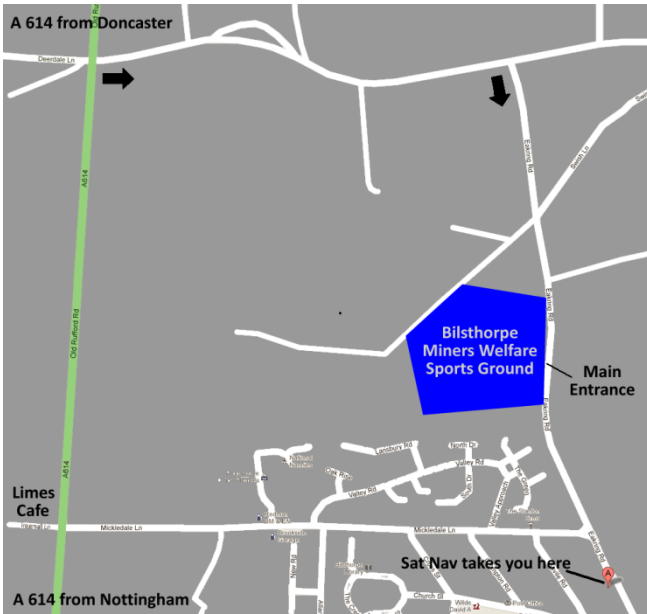

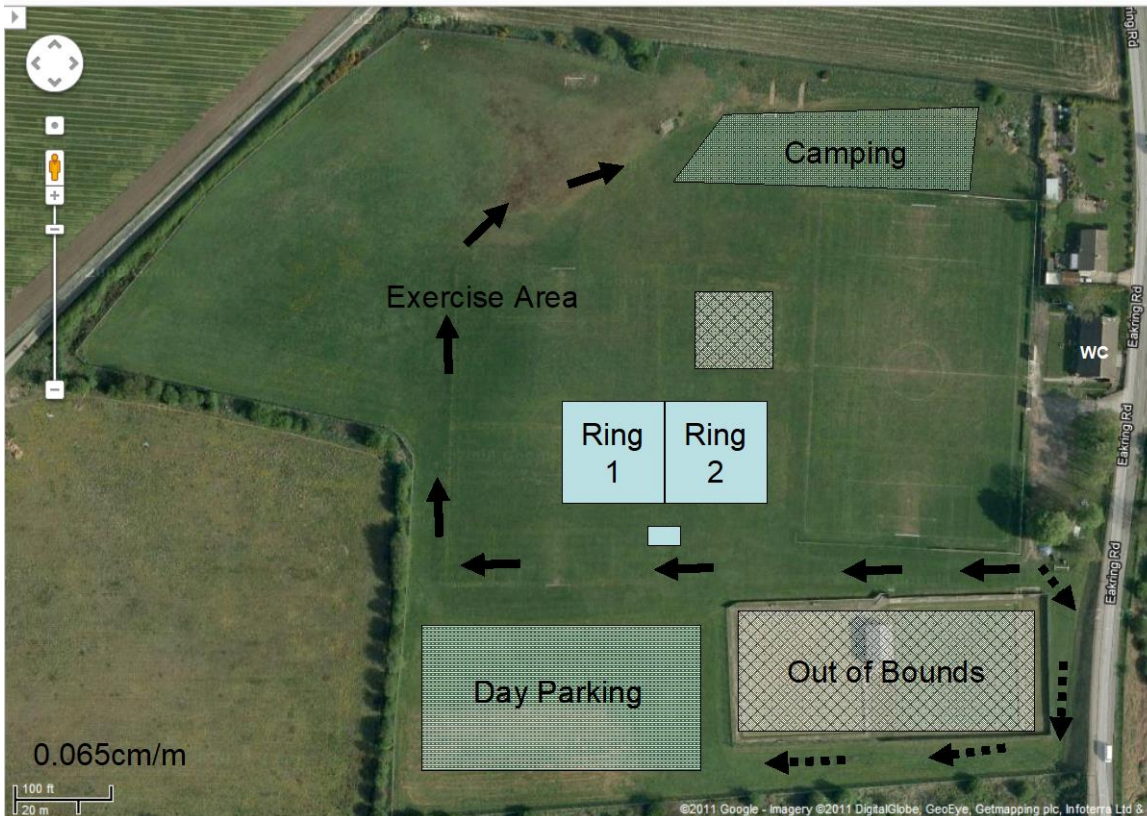
### Directions to venue

Bilsthorpe is located just off the A614 between Doncaster and Nottingham about 2 miles north of the A617 Newark to Mansfield road. Follow the signs to Bilsthorpe Business Park from the A614 turning right if travelling north (next right after the turn at Limes Café) or left if travelling south. Take the right turn towards the Business Park and enter the venue via the main entrance.

**Campers:** Please go around the perimeter of the venue (dotted arrows then solid arrows) to the camping area. Please **do not** drive straight across the pitches!

**Day Parkers:** Please follow the dotted arrows on the map below to the day parking area. Please note layout may change.

**Local Shops:** There are local shops including a Co-op and a couple of takeaways about 2 minutes drive from the venue. Ask at the show for directions.
