Show Information

Happy New Year and welcome to the third of the Agility Nuts Winter Shows for 2021/22 at Arena UK! We hope you and your dogs enjoy the show and we look forward to seeing you at future Agility Nuts Shows. Please take the time to read through the following information as this will help to ensure that the show runs smoothly and finishes at a reasonable time.

COVID-19

Agility Nuts will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid Safe guidelines. We request that facemasks should be worn when walking courses or when queuing to run your dogs.

If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid-19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid-19 they must isolate in line with the Government advice in place on the day of the show (www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/self-isolation-and-treatment/when-to-self-isolate-and-what-to-do/) and should not attend the show if that is the current recommendation.

Walking the courses: Courses can only be walked before the start of each level, with the exception of Elementary, i.e. Starters and Novice Plus ABL and Lge/Int need to walk the courses when they are set at Starters or Novice Plus, respectively, whilst Elementary classes can be walked before the start of the ABL and the Lge/Int classes. Please note that Veteran, Anysize and Nursery classes will run concurrently so must be walked at the same time and run when set at your height.

Getting to the line: Please be aware of when you need to run your dogs! If you have multiple dogs to run please stagger your runs to make sure that the end of the class is not delayed whilst the Judge waits for you to go and get your next dog. Please note what height jumps are set at whilst walking the course and make sure you run when the height is set at the height for your dog.

Not For Competition: If you would like to specifically train in the ring, you need to declare this before you start your run. You MUST break the starting beam on entry into the ring and you will be told when you must leave the ring (approx 45s). Training rounds will not be judged.

Pay on the Day: We will be taking pay on the day entries at a cost of £7.50 per run, payable by cash or card. Payment by cheque will incur an additional £2.50 charge.

Ring Updates & Results: Agility Nuts will be using FPP Live to update ring status and offer live results throughout the show. Follow everything at <http://mobile.firstplaceprocessing.com>. Current League Tables will be available on the Agility Nuts website (www.agilitynuts.co.uk) shortly after the show is over.

Awards: Results will be announced as soon as possible after each class closes. There won't be any formal presentations, so winners' medals, placed rosettes and clear round rosettes, can be collected from the awards table without the need to inform anybody.

Helping at the Show: We ask that all competitors help on one of the rings at some point during the day to enable the smooth running of the show. Even if you can only offer the odd 5 minutes here and there, it all helps. Just ask on the rings if they need any help when you are available to offer some.

About the venue: Arena UK is a superb venue for handlers and dogs, so please make sure that you respect the following to ensure that we will be welcomed back in future years:

- The venue has a strict no smoking policy throughout the entire venue.
- Dogs must be kept on lead at all times except when competing or in the exercise area.
- Dogs must be kept under strict control in the exercise area.
- Dogs are not allowed in the toilets or the café.
- Please pick up after your dogs. There will be black bin bags located by the exercise area and the entrance to the arena for you to dispose of any poo. Please do not dispose of poo in any other bins.
- With the exception of the arena, the car park and the exercise area, all other areas are strictly out of bounds.
- Please ensure that you dispose of all litter in the bins provided.

Parking: There are 2 car parking areas (see map). Please park vehicles sensibly without blocking any other vehicles.

Dogs in cars: It may be winter, but please remember that your dog is vulnerable and at risk if left in a vehicle at high temperatures. Please take care of your dog. If your dog is found to be at risk, forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for the damage caused.

Catering: There is a café on site serving a wide choice of hot and cold food at very reasonable prices. The café will be open all day.

Directions to the venue: Arena UK is less than 1 mile from the A1/B1174 junction between Grantham and Newark. At the junction take the turn to Allington. The venue will be located on your right in just over 0.5 miles. The postcode NG32 2EF should pinpoint the entrance to the venue.

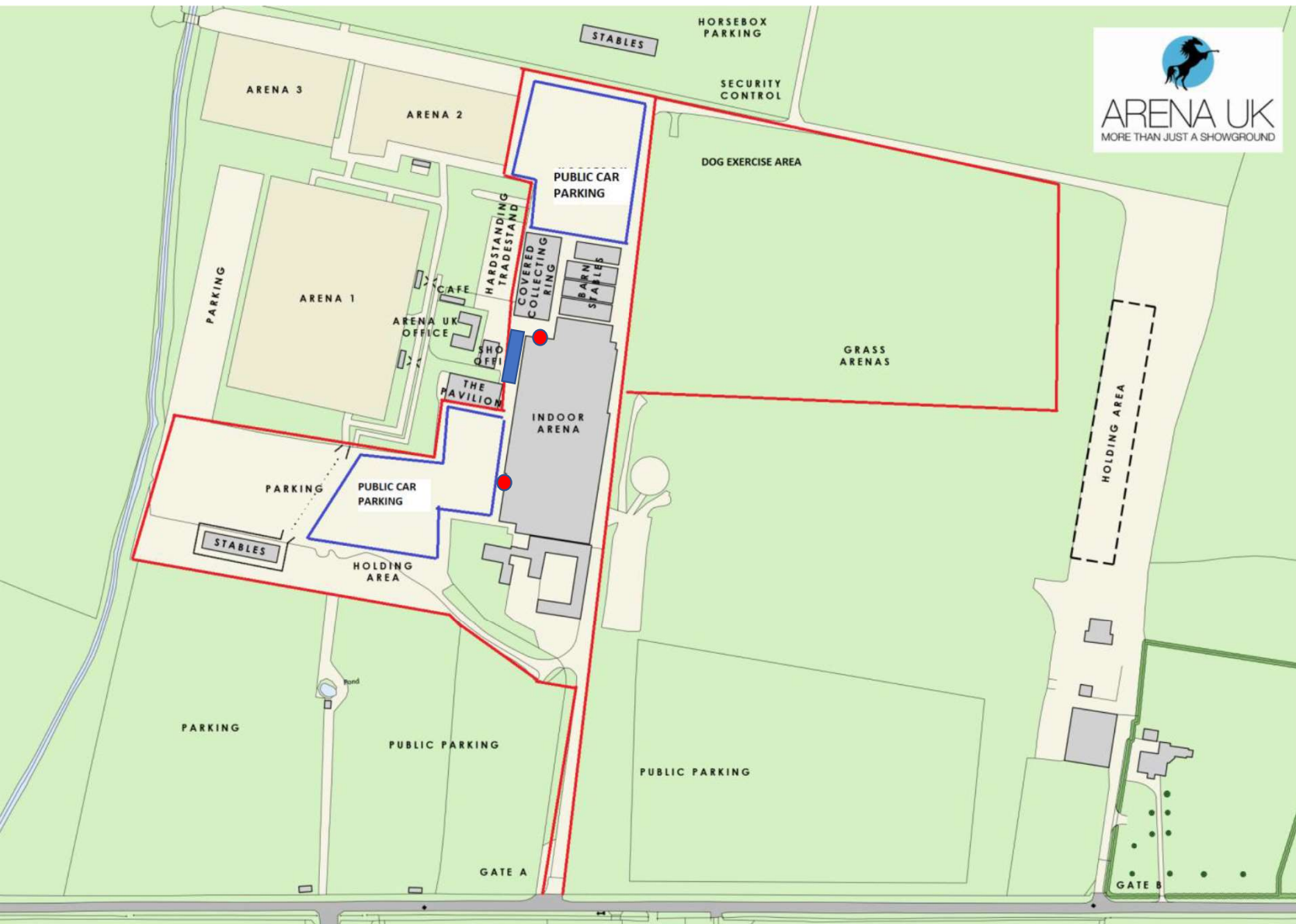
ANDTC is a friendly dog agility training club based near Bingham, Nottinghamshire offering the following classes:
